

Historical Background

- Organized in January 2001 as a coalition of Watertown churches and concerned citizens.
- Community Action Coalition (CAC), Salvation Army, churches and schools collected data that confirmed there was insufficient housing support.
- Visits made to area transitional programs.
- Initial financial donations solicited from Watertown area churches.
- Voluntary Board of Directors appointed in November 2001. Non-profit status created.
- City of Watertown leased houses to Crossroads from April 2002 - Oct. 2019.
- 2021 Changed the mission to focus rental assistance only.
- 2023 Changed name to Crossroads of Watertown Rental Assistance, Inc.

- 1. Entry Assistance Help with first month's rent
- 2. Rental Assistance To help prevent eviction
